BRING THE GOOD NEWS

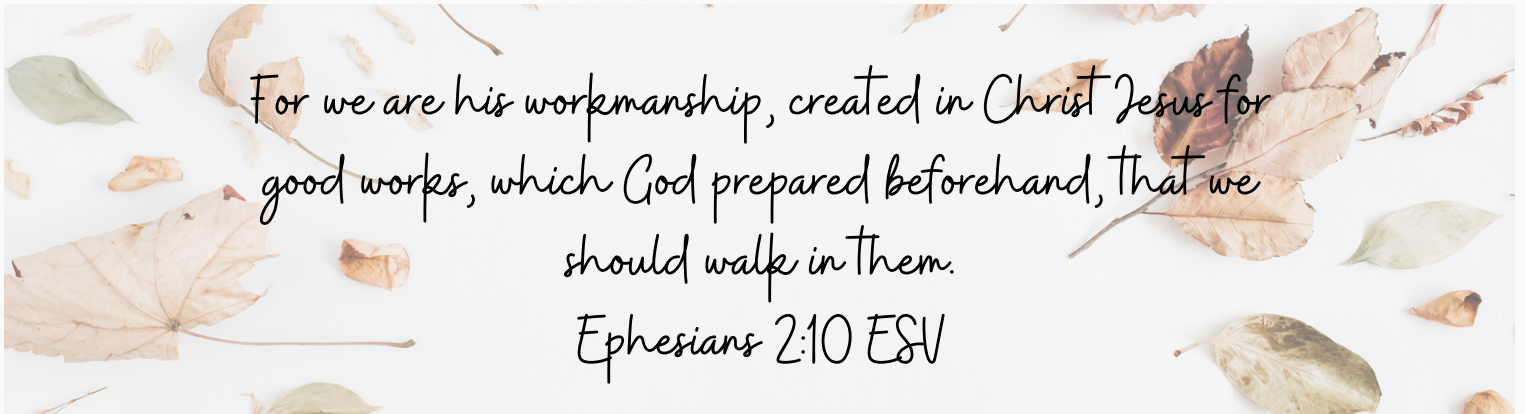

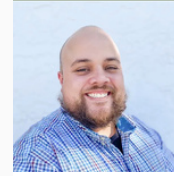
LEAVE A LEGACY

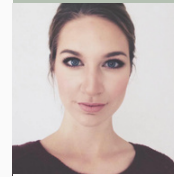
