Creation & the Natural World

Programming from the Institute for Creation Research, Back to Genesis, Creation Moments, and related ministries explores science and the natural world from a biblical creation perspective.

Age of the Earth Looks at the history of geology and asks how old-earth assumptions came to dominate scientific fields and classrooms.	Gems & Rocks Explores diamonds, rubies, sapphires, emeralds, and rocks - their beauty, usefulness, and place in God's creation.
The Quaking Earth Considers earthquakes, their devastating impact, and questions about why this phenomenon exists on the earth.	Astronomy Examines the vast universe, cosmic origins, and humanity's search for discoveries in the heavens.
Botany Explores the design and reproduction of fruit trees and the beauty, fragrance, and usefulness of flowering plants.	Climate Looks at clouds, wind, weather systems, and the ways these powerful parts of our atmosphere affect daily life.
Dinosaurs Examines dinosaur discoveries and competing interpretations of what the fossil evidence means.	Fossil Record Topics include "Bones of Contention" and "Early Man," asking what fossils can - and cannot - tell us about human origins.

Creation, Origins & Life

More subjects covered across Cornerstone's creation-focused programming.

Genome Explores the complexity of the human genome and questions about how genetics is interpreted in discussions of human origins.	Human Body Looks at claims about human evolution and asks whether the evidence supports a continuing evolutionary process in people.
Microbiology Considers the origin of disease and why pain, suffering, and illness exist in a world God created good.	Noah's Ark & Flood Explores questions about the Flood, including competing explanations for the formation of the Grand Canyon.
Oceans Takes listeners beneath the waves to examine the mystery, beauty, and design of the underwater world.	Origin of Life Addresses the creation-and-evolution debate and asks why scientists can examine the same evidence and reach very different conclusions.
Problems with Evolution Includes Ask a Creation Scientist, questions about whether God used evolution, historical discussions of Darwin, and testimonies of people whose views on origins changed.	Radiometric Dating Uses subjects such as diamonds to consider questions about origins, dating, and the history recorded in the natural world.
Zoology From dugongs to dragons, invasive animals, and chemical defenses, this programming explores unusual creatures and their remarkable traits.

Call-In Programs

Hosted by Kerby Anderson. Point of View is a syndicated daily Christian issues talk show. Listeners can hear the program live and participate by phone. The original document notes that the program has been syndicated across more than 360 radio stations in the continental United States.

Recent topics listed in the source document include digital privacy and Flock cameras, proposed federal legislation, land acknowledgements, student protests, Israel, biblical worldview, 9/11 remembrance, socialism, Charlie Kirk, and U.S. political movements.

Janet Parshall has broadcast from the nation's capital for more than three decades. In the Market challenges listeners to examine major news stories and issues being debated in the marketplace of ideas through the lens of God's Word.
